Scouting Ministry Sunday

The mission of the church is to reach out to those within the community, receive them as they are, relate them to God, nurture and equip them, and send them back into the community in order to make the community a more loving and just place in which to live. With that in mind, the United Methodist Men's Foundation established and Office of Civic-Youth-Serving Agencies Scouting Ministries. The purpose of this office is to promote the use of programs across the church and to help local congregations understand how they might use civic youth-serving agencies as an outreach ministry within their community. Nurturing children, teens, and families through outreach and evangelism and incorporating them into the life of the church may have tremendous eternal results for the youth, their family and the Church. The United Methodist Church has chosen to use five youth agencies:

Boy Scouts of America		Girl Scouts of the USA
Camp Fire USA	4-H	Big Brothers Big Sisters

These agencies offer a unique opportunity to minister to young people. The five were chosen because of their Christian teachings, long-standing connection with local congregations, and their recognition of the God and Country Program. We, the Church, are endowed with certain responsibilities that allow scouting and civic youth serving programs to become a ministry. This is what differentiates us from a civic or community-based club.
